



Information about the Multi-Factored Evaluation (MFE)

This file contains information about the MFE process. Become familiar with this information and refer to it as needed.

- If it is determined that your child should be evaluated with an MFE, you will be an important part of that process. You should provide recent evaluations done by Early Intervention therapists to the school so they may use that information also. You will be interviewed about your child and their development.
- When the school has finished their portion, you will be invited to a meeting that shares their findings. Remember, you are a member of that team. After listening to the results, you will be a part of determining if your child is eligible for special services.
- You will be given a copy of your child's MFE for your own records.
